Dear Parents and Carers,

It's that time of year again, and as I'm sure you're aware, your children have been very busy in school rehearsing for their school production. It would be greatly appreciated if you could assist in costume production.

Ideas for costumes:

Angels - Anything white. White dresses, trousers, t-shirts. If your child has wings please don't make them too big! School daps.

Mary/Joseph/Donkey – We have these costumes in school which you are most welcome to borrow. However, if you prefer you can create your own costume. Please let us know. School daps.

Inn Keepers/Shepherds – Dressing gown or long tunics. Tea towel for head covering. School daps.

Stars – Anything black. Stars may be added to black clothing if wished. We have tinsel to go around their head, in school. School daps.

Kings – Royal clothing. Tunic, cloak, trousers. We have a few cloaks in school if you would like to borrow one. School daps.

Camels – Brown or fawn clothing. We have one costume in school so please let us know if you wish to borrow it. School daps.

Chickens – White, yellow or brown costume. A onesie or top and trousers/tights. School daps.

Oxen – Brown clothing. School daps.

Sheep – White clothing. A onesie or white top and trousers/tights. School daps.

Narrators – Something smart. Shirt and trousers or dress. School daps.

Roman Soldiers – Long white t-shirt or tunic and grey trousers. School will provide breastplates and helmets. School daps.

Mice – Brown clothing. A onesie or top and trouser or tights. School daps.

Please remember that this is just a guide. If there are any problems sourcing these items, let us know as soon as possible. The idea is that most of the costumes can be found/made from what already is at home.

Please ensure that costumes are brought into school on Friday 7th December ready for the dress rehearsal. Storage is difficult in school so please don't send costumes in before this date. Costumes should be brought in a clearly named bag.

If you wish to watch the production, it is on Wednesday 12th December at 2:15pm and again on Thursday 13th December at 9:30am.

For health and safety reasons, we have a capacity of 60 seats per performance, allowing each family the opportunity to initially buy 2 tickets each. Should any tickets be left by Monday 10th December, they will be available on a first come first served basis. Tickets are available from the school office from Monday 26th November.

We ask for a minimum donation of £1 a ticket, to cover licensing costs.

We welcome younger siblings (3+ under), but please be aware, due to space, they will need to sit on laps, rather than in pushchairs.
