

School funding

As you will be aware, last week's budget provided £400 for 'little extras'. This does not go anywhere close to addressing the huge shortfall in funding due to an 8% cut in real terms and massively increased costs being passed onto schools due to austerity! Every day brings hard decisions about how we manage our school budget; whenever staff bring an idea or request that will help sustain and improve our provision for pupils, the first question they are asked is 'How much?'. Frequently, my response has to be 'I'm sorry, we simply can't afford it.' Please help by continuing to make your views known to your member of parliament.
