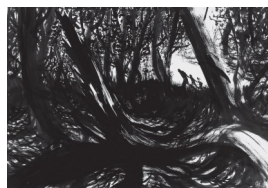

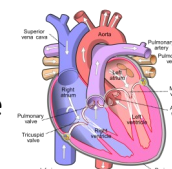
Science: Body Pump, Body Health
