Review of Term 5

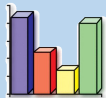

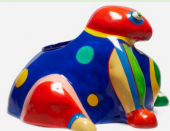

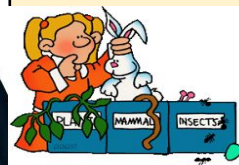
Learning Gem of the Term
