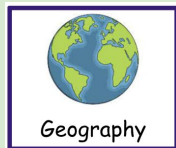

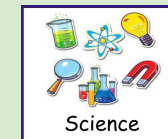

Review of Term 5

We have had so much fun in Venus Class this term

- In **English** we have read the story 'Dragon Post' and looked at how letters are written. We then imagined a pet we could have and wrote a letter from that pet asking people to look after us. The children are improving using their sounds for writing and learnt about statements, questions and commands. We finished the term with NFER tests and I was so impressed with how hard they all tried during those tests.
- In **Maths** we have spent a long time practising counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and introducing the multiplication sign. The children have doubled and halved and have begun exploring division and the principle of equal groups. We finished off the term with NFER tests and again the children worked really hard to show the learning that had taken place this year.
- In **Science** we have been learning about the materials and using scientific words to describe them. The children have used their observation skills and used the vocabulary flexible, stiff, elastic and rigid to describe different materials. The children then measured how far elastic would stretch and made a catapult.
- In **History** we have been learning about the printing press and the beginnings of the Internet and how communication has changed through time.
- In **Art** the children have been exploring the work of Eric Carle and creating collages. The children sketched flora and fauna and then created their own textured paper. They used this hand painted papers to make a collage and then results were astounding.
- A real highlight of the term was celebrating VE day as a whole school. The children sang 'The White cliffs of Dover' with the rest of KS1 to families and then came together for a whole school picnic on the field. The children enjoyed spending time with their friends, celebrating and enjoying their delicious food. Also Venus class have been doing very well with Doodle maths at home, receiving the certificate for most 'Doodling class' a few times this term. Keep up the great work.

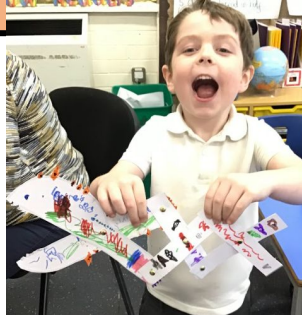
