

## Highlights of the Term

**English:** inspired by the story of the Snow Dragon, we started the term by creating our own dragons from egg boxes. We then used these to plan our own fact files about where our dragons lived, what they eat and their special features. We had so many imaginative ideas. We then shared a book written by Julia Donaldson 'The snail and the whale' which inspired our own journey stories where we visited several continents and saw the nature and animals there. We finished the term by writing a poem inspired by pretending we had wings that helped us fly and using our senses.

**Maths:** We have been working hard at our place value understanding tens and ones. We have also used different strategies to solve addition and subtraction. We have explored doubling numbers and using odd and even numbers. We have now begun to look at a one hundred square.

**Science:** We have been learning all about the human body, the inside and outside parts and our senses. We loved drawing around each other and making body parts with playdough

**Art:** We have been looking at pointillism and creating our own scenic pictures inspired by our work on continents.

**RE:** We have learnt about stories from the bible. We especially enjoyed the story of Noah's Ark

**PE:** We have enjoyed using the gymnastic equipment to develop the ways in which we can move.
