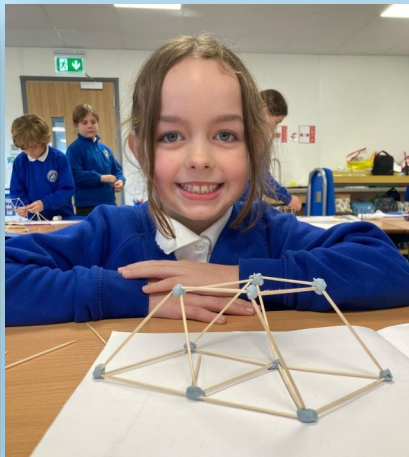
Thank you to all of the children (and parents) who produced a poppy for our display. We will transfer them to the grass beside the church so that they are on show to the wider community.
