Activities Week – KS3

As part of Activities Week this summer, we are organising a trip to Longleat Safari Park on Thursday 18th July. We shall be travelling with Taylors Coaches.

The students will leave school promptly at 9.00 am and return in time for the end of the school day. Students will be expected to bring a packed lunch or purchase lunch on site (if your child receives free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen if required). Please ensure that your child is wearing suitable clothing.

We will have a tour of the safari park, a boat ride then free time when students will be able to move around the park in small groups and have their packed lunch before returning to school. We will have meeting points and a contact number for a member of staff at all times.

The cost of the trip will be £20.00 for the day. Your child has indicated that they would like to attend this trip. In order to confirm their place please complete the consent form attached and pay via Parent Pay. Pupils entitled to Pupil Premium should pay £10.00 by Tuesday 30 April.

Third Part Data Sharing

As this is an off-site activity, there may be a need for us to pass certain data to a third party for example the emergency services in the event of incident requiring these services. The information to be disclosed could include: Name of child, Date of birth, any medical information and other special needs and parental contact information. We also have a legal obligation to enter all details onto a risk management system run by the Local Authority called EEC. The data on EEC will be retained in line with Government Legislation.

Under the General Data Protection Regulations you have the right to object for this information to be passed onto these external bodies, however if you decide not to give permission, it may not be possible for your child to undertake the activity.
