What's involved?

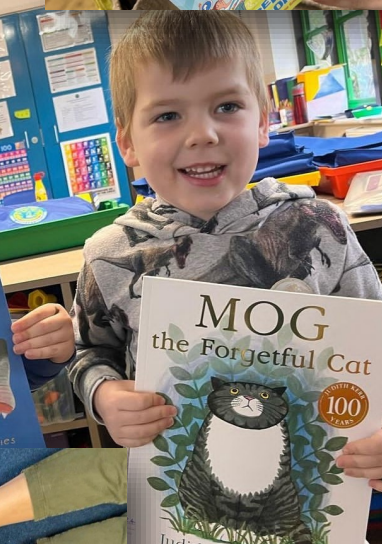
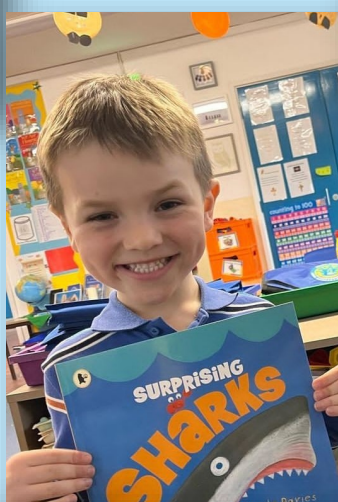
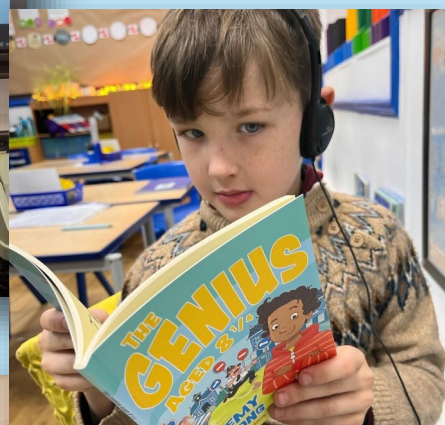
