Dear Parents and Carers

As we near the end of the year, I wanted to tell you a bit more about some changes planned for September and what we hope to do in September, dependent on further government advice.

Firstly, we have two staff leaving us to move on to other schools; Mrs Rowlinson-Baker is moving St Mark's School in Bath and Mrs Kendall is moving to St Lawrence School in Bradford on Avon. I am sure you will join me in wishing them all the best for the future and thanking them for everything they have done for St Dunstan's.

As a result of this, we have carefully considered the leadership structures of the school and have made the following changes and appointments.

Mrs Lewis will now become SENDCO and we have appointed a new Art Teacher Mrs Howell. Mr Jones will move back to Head of Key Stage 4, and Mrs Bevan will now lead on Teaching and Learning. We have appointed a new Assistant Headteacher, Mr Oakwood who will lead on Pastoral Care and Safeguarding. We have also appointed a new Maths teacher, Mrs Loud who will be a familiar face as she did some of her teacher training at St Dunstan's.

Currently, the government has said it would like all year groups back at school in September, however there are not yet any details on how this may look. Subject to further information, our plan is to have all of year 7 in for an induction day on Friday 4th September, with other year groups returning from Monday 7th September. At this point we are planning a normal timetable and curriculum for September. If we receive further clarification from the government regarding September that leads us to change these plans, we will of course write to you.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank parents and carers for their ongoing support with home learning, and also to thank the staff who have worked hard to adapt to a new way of working and to support students in their learning.
