## Anti-Bullying Week 15th - 19th November

As a school, we use our weekly PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic education) sessions to support the emotional development and wellbeing of the children in our care. We have an active Equality Team who meet weekly to promote a sense of equality in our school and promote respect for each other. The Equality team worked hard to launch our new Anti-Bullying charter and our anti-bullying ambassadors are on the playground to offer advice and support. Next week is Anti-Bullying Week. The focus for this year's Anti-Bullying Week is kindness and the theme is 'ONE KIND WORD'.

Every class in our school has a worry box where children can write any worries. These are checked regularly by teachers. We regularly talk to the children about bullying in class but this is the perfect week to really focus our attention on this important topic.

Anti-Bullying Week happens every year in November and we always use this week as a special opportunity to support and highlight what bullying is and what to do if children encounter bullying. - Watching a video stimulus to discuss bullying
- Anti-Bullying Week assembly led by Mr Randell and Miss Biss
- Kindness card initiative
- Revising what our anti-bullying charter states. What does 'STOP' represent?
- Listening to stories linked to our theme
- Friday 19th will be 'Be Yourself Day'. Wear clothes that represent you and who you are.
   Friday 19th of November is also 'Children in Need' day so we are asking the children to bring a charitable donation of £1 in return for wearing clothes that show who they are. We know the great work carried out by Children in Need and really want to support this deserving charity event.
