- Use switchzoo.com to create animals that might survive there

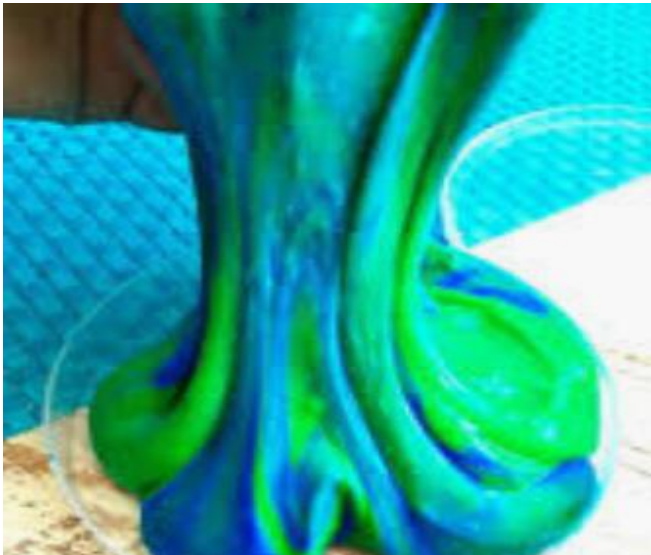
Science ideas –growing up and taking care
