

# Fun Easter Activities

<p><b><u>Egg and Spoon Race</u></b> Try this good old-fashioned outdoor game after your Easter egg hunt is over! Egg and spoon races date back to the late 1800s. All you need are eggs (hard-boiled are the least messy) and metal or wooden spoons for each participant. Race individually or relay-style.</p>	<p><b><u>Decorate an Easter Egg</u></b> Hard boil an egg in a pan of boiling water (get an adult to help you with this). Use pens or paint, decorate your egg to create a cute Easter decoration!</p>	<p><b><u>Make up an Easter rap or song!</u></b> Make up your own song/rap all about Easter or one of your own interests! Why not film it and share it on Seesaw for your classmates to see.</p>	<p><b><u>Duolingo</u></b> Use <a href="https://www.duolingo.com">https://www.duolingo.com</a> to practise your French! Try to learn a new phrase in French or aim to be able to have a short, simple conversation in French with somebody else.</p>	<p><b><u>Make your own game</u></b> Create your own board game, outdoor game/physical activity game or computer game (you could use Purple Mash). You could make it Easter-themed.</p>
<p><b><u>Create your own Newsround News Report!</u></b> Video yourself doing a News Report (Newsround-inspired) reporting what is happening with your Easter holidays at the moment.</p>	<p><b><u>Choreograph your own dance!</u></b> Make up your own dance routine to your favourite song! Why not film it and share it on Seesaw for your classmates to see.</p>	<p><b><u>Baking with Mrs Weaver!</u></b> Watch Mrs Weaver's video (on our website and Seesaw) on how to make Easter biscuits for a delicious Easter treat!</p>	<p><b><u>Scouts 100 Indoor Activities</u></b> Type into Google: "Scouts 100 Indoor Activities", click on the first or second link and have a go at one of their fun indoor activities!</p>	<p><b><u>Keep a diary</u></b> Write a diary entry each day of the Easter holidays about what you have done and enjoyed that day.</p>
<p><b><u>Set up a Treasure Hunt!</u></b> Write clues/riddles and hide them around your house to create a Treasure Hunt for somebody in your family. Maybe you could hide a yummy prize at the end!</p>	<p><b><u>Have an indoor picnic!</u></b> Lay out a picnic mat and enjoy your breakfast/lunch/dinner in the comfort of your own home!</p>	<p><b><u>Make a pizza!</u></b> It's miscellaneous toppings night. Whatever you have laying around the house, that's what's going on your homemade pizza!</p>	<p><b><u>Go for a Nature Walk</u></b> Download the "PictureThis" plant identifier app, go on a nature walk and see how many new species of plant you can find!</p>	<p><b><u>Set up an Easter Egg Hunt!</u></b> Hide chocolate eggs (or drawings of them) around your house to create an Easter Egg Hunt for somebody in your family.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><small>twinkl.com</small></p>
