

## This week's Story: Rumble in the Jungle

English	Choose an animal from the story. Can you create a fact file about that animal?  Think about: What does it look like? Personality? What does it like to eat? Where does it live?	Think about what you might see and hear in the jungle. Write a short description on this.  E.g. I can hear a gorilla beating his chest loudly. I can see a tall giraffe eating leaves.  Extension- Can you use more WOW adjectives (describing words) to make your writing more descriptive?	Design your own animal! Be as creative as you like. Can you label the body parts of your new animal and write a sentence about them?  E.g. My animal has a long neck so he can reach high places.	Create a short poem about your new animal.  Refer back to the story to help you with the structure.	Imagine you have adopted your new animal as a pet! Can you write some instructions for how to take care of them?  E.g.  1. Feed my animal at 8am. 2. Play with my animal at 2pm. 3. Put him to bed at 7pm.  Extension- Add more description to your instructions e.g. what food does he eat?

Can you make up your own song about a jungle animal?	Can you identify and name the animals shown in the pictures?  This will be an activity set on SeeSaw.	Design and make your own animal!  You could draw and colour your animal or even use different materials to make it 3D! Be as creative as you like.	Create a dance of how your animal might move through the jungle.  Film it and show us on SeeSaw!	Computing  Design the habitat (where your animal lives) on Purple Mash.  Geography  On your habitat picture, identify the physical (natural not man-made) features you might find in the jungle.  E.g. river
