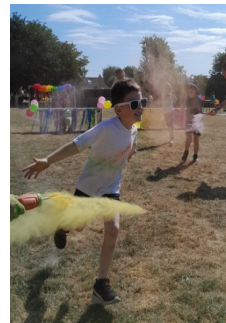

### **Important information:**

- Children will be given eye protection (glasses). In previous years, some children have found it difficult wearing glasses they were not used to. Please feel free to bring in a pair of sunglasses or goggles they will be comfortable in.
- Children should wear old clothes as the colour powder (washable and child friendly) may cause some slight staining. Old tops will be provided if finding old clothes is a problem.
- Your child should also bring their PE kit to change into after the run.
- All classes from nursery to Year 6 will be involved.
- There will be donation buckets available if you wish to support our school further.
- This event will be weather permitting but we will let you know in advance if we need to reschedule
