

Expectation	Details
Physical activity	Cosmic Yoga.
Phonics: 'oo' sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• See video link to Seesaw with the daily sound. Pause it to allow time for the child to write.• Sentence for them to write independently: I went to the zoo, then I went to the moon.• Activity on purple mash linking to the 'oo' sound.• Activity: Go on a hunt around the house and find as many spoons as you can. Come back to the area you have been working and write an 'oo' word for each spoon. Moon, zoo, spoon, roof, boot, room, tooth, broom.
Maths:	<p>Retrieve: place these numbers in order from the smallest to the biggest 16 7 12 6 20 3</p> <p>Activity: addition and subtraction. Write down a selection of addition and subtraction calculations, using a different coloured pencil they have to underline the operation (subtraction or addition) then solve the problem. Encourage them to use pictures and objects to help them.</p> <p>Using the calculations they have completed, ask them to write or stick them in a board game design. See the example:</p>  <p>Do not play the game, as this is for tomorrow's activity.</p>



Physical activity	Joe Wicks 5-minute workout.
Phonics: 'or, oi, oa' sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• See video link to Seesaw with the daily sound. Pause it to allow time for the child to write.• Sentence for them to write independently: She had a 50p coin. She spent it on a boat.• Activity on purple mash linking to the 'or, oi and oa' sound.• Activity: Race to the top. Make a grid of 6x4. In the squares ask your child to write 'or, oi and oa' words. Ask your child to predict which number is going to be the winning number. Roll a dice and the word which it lands on, they must say and cover with an object. The row which is all covered up is the winning number.

Pause it to allow time for the child to write.• Sentence for them to write independently: She said I need my hair cut short. You need a beard trim.• Activity on purple mash linking to the 'air, igh, ear and ure' sound.• Activity: 4 in row. Write down words containing today's sound. Hair, fair, lair, chair, stair, pair, light, bright, night, fright, high, fight, hear, beard, tear, fear, gear, pure, mixture, cure, manure, vulture, picture. 

Physical activity	Joe Wicks 5-minute workout.
Phonics: 'ar and ai' sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• See video link to Seesaw with the daily sound. Pause it to allow time for the child to write.• Sentence for them to write independently: The car is near the park. The car had to wait for the rain to stop.• Activity on purple mash linking to the 'ar and ai' sound.• Activity: Splat! Write out all phase 3 sounds: sh, ch, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, er, ure, air, ow, oi, or, qu, ur. Place the cards on the floor. Either have two players against each other and one person calling the sound (the first person to find the sound) or one person calls whilst the other person finds the sound (to add competition who can find 10 sounds the quickest) <i>We have played this game plenty of times in school, they should be able to teach you</i> □

Ask them to pull two cards from the deck. Ask them to either add or subtract the two numbers. 

Phonics: 'j,x,z,w' sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• See video link to Seesaw with the daily sound. Pause it to allow time for the child to write.• Sentence for them to write independently: Jim and Max went to the zoo and saw a zebra.• Activity on purple mash linking to the 'j, x,z,w' sound.• Activity: When you go to the zoo, what do you see? Can you draw a map of a zoo and label the animals?
Maths:	<p>Retrieve: Write numbers 0-20 and number bonds to 10 or 20. If possible, in the part part whole method:</p>  <p>They should be able to do the retrieve independently.</p> <p>Problem solving using subtraction and addition. Give them these cards: 2 4 6 8 + - = only using these cards, how many different ways can they use them? $2+4=6$</p> <p>Noah saw 12 legs walk by into the Ark. How many creatures did he see?</p>
