## Enrichment Activities 2026 - Student Selection of Activities

Dear Parents and Carers,

Each year at St Dunstan's School our students in Key Stage 3 are offered the opportunity to take part in a range of extra-curricular activities during our annual Enrichment Days.

Further to our letter earlier this month, we are pleased to confirm our Enrichment Day activities that will take place on Tuesday 14th July and Wednesday 15th July.

The list below details the activities available and an indicative cost. Please note that some costs may also vary based on associated costs linked to transport and other expenses and we will try to confirm these as soon as possible. In the meantime please be advised that the costs listed below are indicative only.

Please note that most trips return to school after school hours and parents are required to organise their own transport home.

### Tuesday 14th July

- Crealy Adventure Park - £30.20 **Expected return to the school approx. 4.45pm**
- Longleat - £13.50
- Haynes Motor Museum - £7

### Wednesday 15th July

- Plymouth National Marine Aquarium - £26.50 **Expected return to the school approx 5:45pm**
- Mendip Activities Centre (including tobogganing, dry slope lessons and a low ropes course) - £66.20 **Expected return to the school approx. 4.15pm**
- Bovington Tank Museum - £25 **Expected return to the school approx. 5.15pm**
- Crealy Adventure Park - £30 **Expected return to the school approx. 4.45pm**

There will be a range of in-school enrichment activities available each day, including opportunities to visit local sites such as Glastonbury Abbey and other local landmarks.

Students, alongside parents/carers in order that activity selection and cost has been agreed, will need to use the google form below to select their first and second choice of activity each day, this includes the option to remain in school (a selection form for school activities will be provided at a later date).
