Third Party Data Sharing

As this is an off-site activity, there may be a need for us to pass certain data to a third party for example the emergency services in the event of an incident requiring these services. We also have a legal obligation to enter all details onto a risk management system run by the Local Authority called Evolve. The data on Evolve will be retained in line with Government Legislation.
