Norton Hill students have completed the double once again!

Following last week's phenomenal results in the sixth form, year 11 students have produced yet again another superb set of results well above National figures and reversing the National trend of lower results.

Students, parents/carers and staff gathered in the sixth form centre to enjoy the collection of the highly anticipated GCSE grades.

Norton Hill are pleased to report, outcomes in English, Maths and Science all achieved grade 4+ percentages of above 80%. Students achieving 4+ in English and Maths were 80%. Grade 5's and above were equally as strong with the core subjects all being between 60-70%. These figures would suggest we would move into an even higher category in terms of results, should progress be taken into consideration.

Most pleasing is that the gap between disadvantaged children and the rest of the cohort was significantly less than last year and massively impressive when comparing with National data where the gap still appears to be widening.

This is testament to all the hard work of the staff, students and their parents/carers in partnership.

Headteacher, Gordon Green said, "It is always an honour and a privilege to share in these moments and I am pleased that the overwhelming emotion was one of positivity".
