In Art this term we will be looking at the Art works of the Ancient Egyptians, in particular ancient scrolls. We will use sketchbooks to record our ideas, have a go at making our own paper/scrolls and finally create a zine (mini book) to share our learning from the unit.

In science this term the children will compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. The children will be able to describe how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. They will also recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.



In writing we will be focusing on the story 'The Incredible Book Eating Boy.' We will be looking at the genre 'comedy' and plan our own humorous stories!

## Goldfinch Class Spring 1 Curriculum Overview





We will be learning the song 'Three Little Birds.' The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, elements of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc.) singing and playing instruments are all linked. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other Reggae songs.

## Computing

Children will develop their understanding of what a branching database is and how to create one.



Our RE topic this term is Islam. The children will be learning What Muslims believe about Islam and Iman.



Sports with Mr Groves as usual and we will take a weekly trip to Wren Woods for some outdoor learning.

**PSHE** In PSHE our topic in term 3 will be 'Our dreams and goals' where we will be discussing our own dreams and goals and how to overcome hurdles and challenges on the way to achieving these.

In maths we will be looking at addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.



Our History topic this term is the Ancient Egyptians. We will be learning about the Ancient Egyptian civilisation, the significance of the Nile and life during that time and also what artefacts found, tell us about their belief in the afterlife.
