Our Year 5 camp will run Monday 15th June- Friday 19th June 2020. We would like to invite you to our information evening later on Monday 2nd December at 6pm. Please come along and find out about the exciting camp arrangements.

The camp will be held at Great Wood near Bridgwater, Somerset. Many of our children know the camp well from the Year 4 camp. Our children will be doing a mixture of activities at both Greatwood and its sister site, Kilve Court, which we have carefully chosen to ensure there is a step up in the children's experience helping them develop their confidence and resilience further. Children will be participating in activities such as shelter building, low ropes, climbing wall, rifle shooting and grass sledging - to name a few!!

The Centre, which is run by Somerset County Council, is situated in a beautiful wooded valley. You can find out more about the centre by visiting: <https://www.sseoutdoors.co.uk/>. The Great Wood Activities Manager will attend our camp information evening on 2nd December to give you a greater insight into what your child can expect.

The details of the trip are as follows:

Trip dates: **Monday 15th June to Friday 19th June 2020**

Cost: **£310.00** – inclusive of coach travel, accommodation, food, activities and tuition

Deposit: **£50.00** (non-refundable) to be paid by **Monday 6th January 2020**

Further amounts: **£100.00 by 28th February 2020 and final amount of £160.00 by 27th March 2020.**

We treat Y5 Camp as an important educational event and it sets the scene for our children moving into their final year with us. For many pupils it provides some of the richest experiences of their whole time in primary school.
