Dear Parent/Carer,

We are very much looking forward to the Year 4 residential camp on the 5th/6th of May at Kilve Court. This letter will give you more information and provide a kit list for packing.

If you haven't already completed the Google Form, please do so as soon as possible. This will allow us to collate all the information in preparation for camp. All medication (labelled clearly with your child's full name) needs to be handed in to the office by Friday 1st May so we can check we have everything.

We encourage parents to share transport arrangements to make drop off and pick up easier. If your child is being collected by anyone other than parents please email the school office to confirm who will be picking them up along with a password if it is not an adult already known to the school.

Tuesday 5th May - 12pm Arrival Time

Wednesday 6th May - 1:30pm Pick up Time

The children will need to bring a packed lunch to have on arrival. Weather permitting, the children will eat their packed lunch outside.

The activities the children will be enjoying are:

- Climbing Wall
- Grass Sledging
- Wide Games
- Stream Walk
- Buggy Building

There is a shop that sells 'Kilve Court' souvenirs so if your child wishes to bring some money (Max £5), we will arrange time for a shop visit.

Sleeping arrangements will include two dorms in the old house. One dorm for girls and another for the boys. This will be on the first floor of the building. We have the entire area to ourselves and there is a keycode to gain entrance. Teachers are positioned between the two dorms.

If you have advised us of any dietary requirements, this will be communicated to the kitchen staff at Kilve. It's important that you do let us know if your child is prone to sleep walking or bed wetting so we can plan for this. We will ensure that we take lots of photos and these will be posted on social media for children who have photo permissions.

Kit List for Kilve Court

- Please make sure all kit is labelled. Please make sure your child packs the bag with you so they know what they have. This will allow them to easily locate items.
- Please pack old clothes

Sturdy, comfortable trainers

Welly boots (Required for the stream walk) x1

Long socks for welly boots to prevent chaffing

Waterproof coat x1

Waterproof trousers x1

Underwear x3

Night wear x1 (2 if child is prone to accidents)

Trousers, track suits, leggings x3

Sweatshirt/Fleece/Hoody x3

T-shirts or long sleeved tops x3

Wash bag - toothbrush, toothpaste, flannel, shower gel

Reusable water bottle

Towel (microfibre or easy dry preferred)

Sun hat

Sun cream

Clean footwear for indoor use only (slippers/crocs)

Soft toy

Book

Torch

Duvet or sleeping bag.

Pillow case - pillow will be provided

Bottom sheet

One packet of treats/chocolate (optional)

All medication to be handed into the office by Friday, 1st of May
