Dear Parents/Carers

Firstly, thank you so much for your support over this first half term. Despite the COVID-19 protection measures we are all facing in schools, feedback from children and the reports from parents and staff have been overwhelmingly positive about the return to school. I hope that children will be able to enjoy a restful break and be ready for another half-term of learning

## Uniform

From term 2 (November 3<sup>rd</sup>), children should return to school in full uniform. Given that the weather will be less pleasant over the coming months, please ensure that your children have school jumpers and/or blazers if they are part of the uniform and a waterproof coat. In most Trust schools, the published Risk Assessments require some windows and doors to be open in rooms to allow air to circulate and therefore classrooms may not be as warm as they have been in previous years. Please contact your school if you need any financial support with uniform.

## School Trips

We will not be running any school trips between now and Christmas except where there is an examination course requirement at GCSE or A level. I intend to review this in December and update all parents about our plans for educational visits in the New Year.

## COVID protection

Please remind your children of the importance of good hand hygiene and the 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it' slogan around colds etc. In winter we naturally have more children and staff who are unwell with colds and therefore having tissues and trying to stop the spread of minor viruses is really important, particularly given the threat of Covid-19.

## Parent consultation

A number of the Trust schools will be trialling new software for video conferencing for parent consultation evenings. This will allow parents to see staff without visiting schools. Time slots will be available for booking and the software counts down the time left in the appointment. I have asked staff to be concise in their communications with you and hope that one of the positive benefits of Covid-19 will be reduced waiting times for appointments, particularly in secondary schools!

Full details of how parents' evenings will be conducted will be communicated to you directly from your child's school.

## Assessment of progress

We are running the usual programme of assessments for all children and the full curriculum in all schools. Progress data will soon be available to parents across all schools via the usual systems.

## GCSE and A level Examination 2021

The DFE have now decided that GCSE and A level examinations will be delayed by 3 weeks to allow time for children to catch up on work missed. Further details will be published in due course.

## Trust Board

Many of you will be aware that there is a Trust Board that governs the Midsomer Norton Schools' Partnership. The membership of this group are largely local people, many of whom have children in the Trust schools. I am pleased to announce that Margaret Simmons-Bird has agreed to join the Trust. Margaret was Head of School Improvement at BANES Local Authority and will no doubt keep us on track in terms of pupil progress and other aspects of school development.

## Governors

All schools require good governance and senior leaders to be held to account, we currently have a number of voluntary vacancies across the Trust for governors at both primary and secondary level.
