## <u>Website</u>

We are continually updating our website with useful ideas, activities and website links to help your child engage with their learning at home. Please continue to check it regularly. Those of you with a Facebook account can join the Clutton PTFA page where Sophie Piddock (Chair) is doing a great job of sharing learning ideas and photos.

## Class Pages

Over the last fortnight, teachers have been busy getting to grips with technology and each class now has their very own google sites class page. Those of you who have children in Cherry Class will know how successful this has been as a way of communicating and sharing learning. We have therefore taken this forward and applied this way of learning to all classes in the school. The website address for each class will be emailed out to you along with the learning timetable.

Our teachers are now confident in making short videos which can explain and teach new concepts. These will all be uploaded onto the relevant class page and it will clearly state on the timetable when you need to watch them. We want to help children to stay motivated and engaged, and hope that seeing teachers and hearing their voices showing them how to complete their learning will help in this. Videos will include daily storytime and phonics lessons for our younger children. Miss Swann (our PGCE student) in Oak Class will even be providing french lessons for our KS2 pupils! We have had lots of positive feedback about the timetable, how it's easy to use and helps your child(ren) keep some structure to their day. We will continue to email these to you on a fortnightly basis and these will also be displayed on the class pages and website.

Being a parent, a teacher and working from home all at the same time is challenging and at times will feel impossible.
