We hope you all had a lovely summer break. Before the start of term, we thought it would be useful to send out a few reminders about the arrangements for the year ahead.

Times of the Day

We are returning to the usual start and end times for the school. This means that the day begins at 8:50am and ends at 3:15pm. For those children starting in Reception, their timetable is as follows:

w/c September 6th: 8.50am - 1pm

w/c September 13th: 8.50am - 3.15pm (normal school day)

Drop off

Gates will open at 8.45am for parents and children to access the school site. The school bell will ring at 8.50am at which point the children in Years 1 -6 will line up in their respective classes on the front playground and will be taken into the school by their class teacher.

Reception children will line up outside Cherry class.

Pick up

Gates will open at 3.10 for parents to access the school grounds. Children in Years 1-6 will be brought round to the front playground for collection. Children in Reception can be collected from outside their classroom.

N.B. It is essential to let the school office know if your child is going home with another child or different adult to normal.

School Uniform

Normal uniform is now expected to be worn in school including a school jumper/cardigan with the logo on. The only difference is that children will still come to school on PE days wearing their PE kits. These days will be passed on to you by your child's teacher before term begins.

School Dinners

These need to be ordered by the end of Thursday each week for the following week. If you forget, please contact the school office.



Covid Procedures

In line with the Government's Covid Operational Guidance for schools, the majority of the school day will return to normal. There will be no bubbles, children will be able share equipment and breaktimes will not be staggered. We will still be keeping spaces well-ventilated and ensuring good hygiene. Extra cleaning regimes will also be maintained and should there be any confirmed cases of Covid-19, then we will be following public health advice on testing and isolation.
