When attending the revision sessions, students need to be in the reception area 10 minutes before the session is due to start; 9:50 for morning sessions and 12:20 for afternoon sessions. The member of staff who is running the session will need to collect the students from the reception area. Students who arrive late will be unable to enter the school premises. Students do not need to wear a school uniform to attend the revision sessions.

If your child is ill on the day of the revision session, please email me using the email address below, so that we can make staff aware of the absence. If students are signed up and do not attend the sessions, the school is obligated to contact home and investigate the absence. Clearly this is extra work for school staff, so please be proactive with letting us know about last minute absences. Please also note that staff are giving up time in their holidays as well as preparing the correct number of resources so, if students sign up, they are expected to make every effort to attend.
