Dear Parent or Carer,

I'm excited to share with you an innovative new website we have developed to help support your child's progress in Mathematics. The MET Web Portal puts all of your child's Maths data right at their fingertips, making it easy for them to understand their strengths and areas where they can improve.

Accessing the MET Web Portal is simple - just click the link on the home page of The MET Site <https://met.midsomernortonschoolspartnership.com/> that looks like this:



Once logged in, you and your child will see a clear summary of their strengths and areas for development in each strand of the secondary Mathematics curriculum. You'll also be able to view all of their Maths test results, with a helpful breakdown highlighting exactly where they're excelling and what they still need to work on.

The MET Web Portal has been designed to support students to take steps to improve. Each highlighted skill links to The MET Site, with prompts, videos and practice questions. There is even a personalised revision Solo Mission that zeros in on the skills they most need to secure for future exam success.

The MET Web Portal is accessible on desktop browsers and mobile devices. Students must use their school username to login, as they would do to access their google classrooms.
