# Catering

From September 2022 the catering at Buckler's Mead Academy will be moving in-house and will offer a selection of meal options for both students and staff, on a three week rotation. Menus will be published on the Buckler's Mead website in due course, though please note that these can be subject to change depending on availability of raw ingredients and what is in season.

Some of our freshly cooked main meals need to be pre-ordered. If your child would like one of these meals, please could they ask one of our Kitchen staff as early as possible and they will be pleased to help.

Those students entitled to a free school meal will have £2.50 to spend at lunch service each day. This provides a main meal, drink and either fruit or dessert. Please note that any unspent amounts are not carried forward to subsequent days. There is also a free to use water cooler in the refectory, available to all students.

To support the Trust's policy on maintaining cashless schools, all purchases will need to be made via a student's catering account, with funds credited via ParentPay. The existing cash unit in the refectory will no longer be available from September. Any parent who requires a reminder of the initial details required to set up their ParentPay facility should email <u>office@bucklersmeadacademy.com</u> and we shall be pleased to reissue your codes.

The Trust suggests a daily spend limit for secondary pupils of £7.50. A lower limit can be applied upon request.

#### Arrangements for Last Day of Summer Term

Due to the Jubilee Day on Friday 22 July 2022, the last day of term will be Thursday 21 July 2022. We will finish at lunchtime. Students will return to their tutor groups at 11.55 pm (at the end of Period 3).

If you have any issues with childcare arrangements and need your child to stay in the academy until the end of the day, please contact the main office.
