The GCSE Mathematics examinations are fast approaching, so I thought I'd take this opportunity to provide some advice on how you can support your child with their final preparations.

Your child is sitting the Edexcel 1MA1 GCSE Mathematics (9-1) course and the dates of the examinations are as follows:

Paper 1 – Non-Calculator 90 minutes	Paper 2 – Calculator 90 minutes	Paper 3 – Calculator 90 minutes
Friday 20 May – 9 AM	Tuesday 7 June – 9 AM	Monday 13 June – 9 AM

This year the exam board provided us with detailed advance information about the content to be examined in each paper. You can find full details of this information on our Mathematics Expertise Tower website:

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For each exam we have carefully designed practice papers that cover precisely the topics described in the advance information. In class your child has been revising for and working through these practice papers. You can also get access to these practice papers and worked solutions via the links above.

In each practice paper we have included QR barcodes next to each question which, when scanned with a mobile phone camera, link directly to the page on our MET website with advice, video guides and further practice for that specific topic.

By now your child will have a collection of these papers with marking and corrections, which they can bring home and base their revision on. The very best thing they can do now, is to carefully go over the questions they got wrong, scanning the QR barcodes, watching the videos and completing further practice on those topics.
