Following on from our 'People Who Help Us' topic and to enrich the area of learning 'Understanding the World', we will be visiting Court Farm Country Park in Banwell, North Somerset on Tuesday 16th June 2023.

The children will have the opportunity to go on a tour of the farm including the Owl and the Animal Barns.

We will be leaving school at 8.45am and we will be leaving the venue at 2.15pm. We anticipate returning to school around 3.00pm but we will keep you updated via text if traffic causes any problems on the day!

Your child will need:

We may do this as we have had many families ask if they can be given this choice before a trip is cancelled. We will confirm by Wednesday 17th May if the trip is not able to go ahead.

We require a number of parent helpers to accompany us. If you are able to help on the day, please advise the office as soon as possible.
