#### Our School Improvement Plan

We saw some great developments last year, which are already having an impact as demonstrated by our excellent outcomes.

This year, we will be focusing on:

- Bedding down changes introduced last year
- A review of our school curriculum to ensure it excites, inspires and engages
- Maths times tables
- Literacy spelling and handwriting
- Supporting the physical and mental well-being of our children, families and staff
- Improving our communication and visibility in the community

#### Changes for this year

There are many positive developments in the pipeline for this year, many of them influenced by the feedback parents and carers provided via the Parent Survey.

- In the next couple of weeks, we will have a brand new website incorporating our own Facebook page (and twitter feed) and live parent calendar so that parents can easily keep up to date with what is happening.
- We will be holding termly Parents Forum an informal chance to find out more about a particular theme and provide feedback over tea and coffee. The first forum will be on 4<sup>th</sup> October, at 1:45pm and will focus on behavior.
- We continue to broaden the opportunities we offer our children. All of our children will benefit from Forest School activities for one session a week for a term. We have also managed to dramatically increase our programme of extra-curricula activities for all ages (Please see today's letter). You can also view a <u>slideshow online</u> to give you and your child an idea of what each club involves.



Parent Pay - Lunches Current Year 3 children will need to pay for school lunches from September so please sign up to ParentPay if you haven't already done so. Contact the office for an activation letter.

Please note - From September all dinner money must be paid in advance. There will be no facility to go into debt on ParentPay and we will be chasing payment on a daily basis! Please be aware if we don't receive payment in advance, there is a possibility your child will not get a school meal and you will be asked to provide a packed lunch.

#### Visitor access to school

Please remember that visitors, including parents, can no longer access the school via the lower entrance. All visitors are asked to enter via the main entrance and sign in at Reception. Thank you for supporting us in keeping the school site secure.


#### **Drop Off and Read**
