We have seen a lot of excellent learning this week and on walks around the school, it has been great to see so many children working hard and collaborating well with each other. There has been a calm and focused atmosphere in every classroom and it has been lovely seeing our new Reception enjoying their first couple of weeks with Mrs Layland and her team.

We would like to remind you of the times at the beginning of the day, to ensure children are in school ready to learn with the rest of their class. The gate is opened for the Robins at 8:30am and children can arrive any time from then. They will need to be supervised on the playground until a member of staff comes out at 8:40am. The bell is rung at 8:45am and then children are taken into class and registered. Any children not in class at 8:50am are marked late on the register; the playground gate is also closed by this time so that children arriving then have to come in through the main gate. We thank you for your support in making sure your children are all in school on time.

Last week, we mentioned school uniform in the newsletter and we have been pleased to see improvements this week. Can we also clarify that the only jewellery that can be worn are stud earrings, although children may also wear a watch as long as it is not a 'smart watch'. On another note, the wearing of makeup in school is not permitted.

As you may have noticed from the Google Form sent home this week regarding permissions, we are trying to make things easier in terms of paperwork this year. In the past we have sent out a lot of letters, permission slips etc. and although sometimes we do need to send paper copies - such as the data collection sheets - the majority of letters can be sent online. We hope this makes things a little simpler for you all.
