#### Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome back to school after the half-term break. It was a pleasure to see so many parents and carers at our Parents' Evenings and Great Art Exhibition this week. We have received wonderful feedback about our children's artwork with many families 'investing' in our up and coming young artists. Thank you very much to everybody for your generosity; we managed to raise over £500 in much needed funds to help ensure that we are able to continue to offer the broad, balanced and creative curriculum that we are so proud of.

## School Funding

Talking of funding, I would like to appeal for your support in asking parliament to debate an increase to school funding on 4<sup>th</sup> March by clicking on this <u>link</u>. All schools, including our own, are facing huge pressures and making tough decisions on a daily basis. You can find out greater detail about just how schools in our



local area are faring by visiting the Commons Library <u>here</u>. According to the website, in real terms, schools in the England have seen their budget drop 4.9% over the past 5 years but in our constituency the drop has been 6.7%! This at a time of massively increased costs due to increased pensions and national insurance contributions schools must pay and cuts to local services which mean they are no longer provided free to school but must be bought in instead.

Due to the pressures mentioned above, we are appealing for volunteers to help out on our Key Stage 1 Revamp morning Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> March 9:00am-1:00pm. ## Healthy packed lunches

Please ensure that your child's lunchbox is healthy and does not include items that contain nuts. Also Nursery snacks should not contain biscuits, cakes or chocolate. No fizzy drinks allowed in school. Drinks bottles that children have in the class should only contain water.

## Unauthorised holiday

Please remember that term-time holiday can only be authorised in <u>exceptional</u> circumstances. Parents who take unauthorised holiday are at risk of being fined £60 <u>per child</u>, <u>per</u> <u>parent</u>. For a family with two children this equates to a fine of £240.

## E-safety/Managing online time

Please see this week's letter about e-safety and a reported 'game' causing upset to children. Whilst the media is now saying that this scare was blown out of proportion, this is a timely reminder of just how important it is for parents and carers to be aware of what their children are doing online. Please, please make sure that you closely supervise your child. I would also like to take the chance to urge parents and carers to limit screen time as head teachers and teachers around the country are increasingly concerned at the negative impact it can have - especially on children's willingness to read. My own 12 year old son has a 1 hour limit on a week night and a 2 hour limit on the weekends; he doesn't like it - but he doesn't have a choice!

#### World Book Day/ Book at Bed time

It's World Book Day on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March. As always, children are invited to come dressed as their favourite book character. At 5:00pm on that day, we will also be enjoying Book at Bedtime. The children are invited to come back to school in their pyjamas to enjoy a hot chocolate and biscuit and listen to stories read by staff. We also have a return visit from Andy Seed the children's author who will be working with each phase during the day on Wednesday.


