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News from the Classrooms





This week we spend a lot of time outdoors enjoying the amazing weather. In Geography, the Kingfishers explored the school grounds in search of signs of Spring. We also had lots of fun in the newly open playground. On Friday we made fantastic red noses to raise money for Comic Relief.



This week during English, Starlings have transformed into reporters and have been looking at Newspaper articles and the features included in these. After watching the build of the new play equipment, they have reported on the construction as well as the excitement that is building around the school; carrying out interviews and using their skills to write their very own articles. We have some budding reporters among us!



We have had so much fun in Goldfinch class this week learning all about Comic Relief and what it stands for. We especially enjoyed decorating our red noses and pulling funny faces to put them on. We hope our parents will love them as much as we do!



In Science, the Year 6s conducted an experiment about osmosis, when water travels from a high concentration to a low concentration. They were using gummy bears left in different solutions (salt water, vinegar, etc.) to see where the water and sugar in the gummy bears travelled to, making them either bigger or smaller.



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
