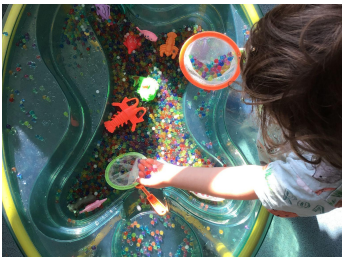

## News from the Classrooms



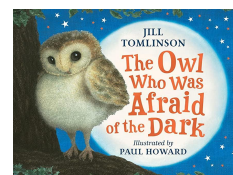
This week in Robins our topic has been 'Under the sea', we've been reading the book Rainbow Fish and making our own rainbow fish. We've also been exploring what sinks and what floats.



This week Kingfishers learned about travelling and living in Hong Kong. We continued our learning about space, particularly the Solar System and made a space station/rocket with junk modelling.
