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Thought of the Week

'Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things..' (John 1:5)

The verse this week is applicable to all of us, whatever walk of life we come from.

'The striking word' in this verse is the word 'whatever'.

John Ortberg, an author and speaker writes, 'Our minds are being shaped all the time, but we have great freedom to pursue minds that flourish. As a bee that can find nectar in all kinds of flowers, we are now free - even commanded - to feed our mind on noble thoughts wherever we find them. The Bible itself commands us to look beyond the Bible to feed our minds.'

'Whatever is lovely.' Think about something that is "lovely" to you. Maybe a sunset (or sunrise), a favourite novel, a holiday memory, the face of a loved one, or some music that really brings you joy.

'Let your mind dwell there for a moment,' John continues. 'Give it directed mental focus. You just obeyed the Bible. That "counts".'

When we experience something of beauty and focus on it, we experience what psychologist Jonathan Haidt called "elevation". We can feel a slight expansion in our chest, we can feel lighter on our feet. 'Our emotions are inspired and we want to become more excellent ourselves...That is spiritual.'

This week, try and take a moment, maybe each day to focus your attention on something that is "lovely" to you, something that brings you joy, someone who lifts your spirits. We all need an "elevated" experience, we all need a moment of spirituality.

Focus and enjoy!


