pleasure to be able to plan events where the house teams spend time together - the recent wellness day for example. The token reward is a further way for the children to work as a team.




So, how do children win tokens for their

Thought of the Week

'God saw all that he had made, and it was very good.' (Genesis 1:31)

What is your most valued possession? If there was a fire in your house and all your family and pets were safe, what one thing would you grab before you left?

For each of us it is likely to be something different and whatever it is, even though it may not have a lot of financial value, it will be of value to you.

We give our possessions worth and value. The objects themselves cannot create their own worth or value. A car cannot compare its value with another car, our phones don't tell us how much they are worth and even our pets won't complain if they feel that our care and attention doesn't match up to the value they aren't able to give themselves.

Like our possessions, we cannot create our own value, we cannot give ourselves worth and we cannot earn it either. Worth can only be given to us.

When you were growing up, the care and attention that you were given by your parents or carers would have shown you how much you were worth and how much you were valued. If we have partners and children, we can also show them how much they are worth and how much they are valued by our love towards them.

Too often, we try and create our own worth or try and earn our worth and value. But like our possessions and our pets, we can't do this - it doesn't work. Our worth can only be given or ascribed to us by others. In the first book of the Bible, it says that God created everything. Each time he created something else, he said it was good. Only after he had created humans did he then go on to say that it was 'very good'.

Right from the beginning, God ascribed worth and value to us. He made it clear that we were of more worth and value than the rest of creation. In fact, the original Hebrew word for 'very good' is 'tov' which literally means to be in harmony with God. Unlike the rest of the animal kingdom, we were created to be in harmony with God and it was God who first gave us our worth and value.

So next time you try to earn your worth and prove your value, stop and remind yourself that it is impossible. Who in your life gives you your worth and value?
