

English



This term, we will be looking at three different types of writing: recount letters, poems and stories. The children will be learning about the key features of each, and writing their own (including a letter to King Charles III)!

Science

We are learning about collage and textiles this term. We will explore different materials through collage, and learn how to sew in order to make a patchwork design!

RE



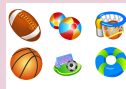
