Concerns about uniform and PE kit not being consistent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We sent out an updated uniform policy at the end of term 5 to ensure new shoes or uniform bought before the summer holidays are appropriate.</li> <li>• We will be monitoring school uniform/PE kit from September onwards.</li> </ul>
Concerns about behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We have purchased new Golden Rules' signage for all classrooms to make expectations clear.</li> <li>• We have undertaken an extensive review of our values - these will be embedded in all we do in school.</li> <li>• We have updated our behaviour policy to make it much tighter and simpler to follow and be understood by children, parents and staff.</li> <li>• We have set time aside at our INSET Days to ensure there is clarity around the behaviour policy with staff to ensure consistency.</li> <li>• This will be shared with parents early in Term 1.</li> <li>• Parents will be informed at an earlier stage to limit low-level behaviours.</li> </ul>
Understanding children's progress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open door Wednesday was infrequently taken up by parents. We will move this to alternate Fridays straight after school when there is a Celebration Assembly and more parents are on site.</li> <li>• After children have completed their autumn and spring assessments, we will share these results with parents via a 'report card', this will be in addition to our autumn and spring Parents' Evenings and our open offer to discuss children's end of year reports.</li> </ul>
