I am delighted to announce that our Early Years Foundation Stage class will be open for nursery children and Reception children 5 days a week from January 2023. Amanda Bottle, who has already devoted a great deal of time in school as a volunteer, has been appointed as an Early Years Apprentice. Mrs Hunt will also be working in both Early Years and in Key Stage 1/2.

School timings

As explained previously, the government has stated that by September 2023, all schools must provide 32.5 hours of provision a week (including breaks). The school day at Hemington begins at 8:50am and finishes at 3:10pm which equates to 31.6 hours. We have decided to extend the school day by 5 minutes at either end of the day for Reception - Year 6. Lessons will begin at 8:45am and finish 3:15pm from January; however, given this is a transitional period, the register will be taken at 8:50am. From September 2023 the register will be taken at 8:45am. The nursery children will continue to attend 9:00am - 3:00pm.



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Keeping our children safe

In order to assist children to arrive punctually, the school gates will be open at 8:40 am. Although the school is on a very quiet road, there are concerns about road safety. Therefore from January, parents and carers are invited to come into the playground area in front of the school building once the gates are opened at the beginning and end of the day.
