## Tuesday 13th December: Nativity

Parents and carers are invited to see our children perform our nativity play 'Whoops-a-daisy Angel'. Please arrive for 2:15pm. Our neighbours, Mr and Mrs Simper, have very kindly offered to let families park in their field as they did in the summer. Please drive in slowly and carefully, given the ground conditions this time of year. We will be serving teas/ coffees and mince pies after the play from 2:55-3:15pm. In order to help with seating and catering arrangements, we are restricting families to two invites in the first instance. *Please email our school office by the end of school on Friday to indicate if you are able to attend and how many seats you require (if you have not already told Mr Randell at the gate).* If there are spare seats, we may be able to offer additional seats to families who need them.

## Timings

## **Breakfast Club and After School Club**

Breakfast Club is available from 8am. Although heavily subsidised, we are having to increase the cost to £2 per session. After School Club is available until 4.15pm. Please ensure your child is collected on time. The cost of After School Club will increase to £2.50. A reminder that parents are required to book Breakfast Club and Afterschool Club in advance via Parent Pay. Please do this by Friday for the following week. However, we understand that circumstances change at short notice and, therefore, if it is an emergency, please contact the office to book a session at short-notice.
