Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, the National Education Union (NEU) has decided to take industrial action. The industrial action relates to teacher members of the NEU and is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over pay and funding.

At this point in time, it appears as though strike action will still take place on the following dates on Thursday 2nd March. I am writing to give you as much notice as possible so that you can make suitable arrangements for your child.

The school will be significantly impacted by the strike action and will be closed for many pupils.

Sunbeams Nursery, Sun Preschool and Moon Reception Class will be fully open. All children in these classes should attend school as normal.

Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 (Y1-Y6) will remain open for key children. Parents of these children will be contacted directly. If you are not contacted by Friday 2:00pm and feel that your child does fall into this category, please contact the school office.

Sunbeams Nursery and Sun class will remain open as usual on these dates.

Breakfast Club, After School Care will operate as usual.

Drop off/ Pick up: Children attending Reception/ Sun Pre-School and Sunbeams Nursery should enter school via the normal entrances. All children in Year 1 - Year 6 should enter school via the top playground.

I'm sorry that you will have to make alternative arrangements for your child at short notice, and that they will experience disruption to their education. I understand that this situation may be frustrating, and ask that all members of our school community continue to treat each other with respect. Midsomer Norton Primary School remains committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our pupils and delivering high-quality teaching.

We are working closely with our staff union representatives to keep up to date with the situation, and I will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further.
