All children will receive expert teaching from P.E. lessons throughout the two terms, ensuring good quality experiences. All children will be provided with travel to The Blue School to participate in multi-schools sports activities every term, allowing them to experience a wide range of sports and the opportunity to work with a wider range of children. These activities would not run without the fund as school does not have the available monies and many parents would not be in the position to pay for all these activities.

We believe swimming is an important life skill. Children from Y2 to Y6 swim for half the academic year (and Y1 for ½ term). This year the P.E. and Sports fund is paying for coach travel and subsidising the cost of swimming. This use of funding ensures that children in our school are able to learn to swim over an extended period of time without making the cost to parents prohibitive.

For those children who are particularly interested in sport, the fund provides opportunities for all to participate rather than only those who could afford it. The fund pays for membership of the local cross country league and transport to the meets. It also subsidised the cost of after-school sports clubs provided by a local company.
