




Transition

Buckler's Mead Academy is well known as a caring academy.

Our transition for students is excellent and places an emphasis on students **feeling at ease**, even before their first day in the academy. On joining the academy, students are placed into mixed ability tutor groups and remain in that tutor group for their five years at the academy.

Primary Friendships

As part of the transition process we endeavour to ensure students are with some of their friends from their primary school. Your child's tutor and our pastoral leads are at the forefront. Their roles are to guide and support students through their educational journey.

Other key staff such as Achievement Leads and Senior Leaders, are also involved in the transition process ensuring that students and parents are supported and valued.

Relationships with our partner Primary schools are extremely positive with a high level of collaboration and mutual respect.

Regular meetings, visits and collaborative ventures are scheduled between our family of schools so that students know various key staff and feel comfortable in their new surroundings before they start in September.

A Caring Academy

High quality pastoral provision is the gateway to academic success and personal development. At Buckler's Mead we are committed to ensuring an inspiring education for all, that includes a respectful and inclusive Academy community, and supporting students to be ready, respectful and responsible. Students are provided with opportunities to develop and understand their personal development, morals, and habitual behaviour. Students hold sky high aspirations, develop skills and confidence in developing and maintaining successful relationships and are offered the opportunity to develop the skills of enterprise and self-motivation. We encourage students to be positive and creative, and develop the skills of resilience and reflection. Students are effectively supported, and where appropriate, provided with personalised provision to support their additional educational needs, including those with medical needs.

The Pastoral Team will share developed knowledge of students and their needs, strengths and barriers to learning to support high quality teaching and relationships between staff and students.



Students have the opportunity to play a role in Academy decisions and development through student voice, and understand the world they live in through opportunities for cultural capital. Students experience healthy competition and success through a flourishing house system, and are recognised for personal efforts and successes through the rewards system and celebration opportunities.

The Student Support structure allows the Academy to successfully engage parents and carers in the learning of their young person and forges strong and impactful community relationships. Students hold high standards for themselves for attendance, punctuality, behaviour, preparation and presentation and are effectively supported to overcome challenges they may face.

Excellent Facilities

The excellent facilities at Buckler's Mead Academy enhance our students' education and personal development – it is a place students feel safe and want to learn. Our commitment is to continue to develop the site even further to provide some of the best facilities in the country.

Educational Facilities

- We have eight dedicated ICT suites enabling students to apply ICT skills across the curriculum.
- Our fully resourced study centre offers a safe and quiet place for independent learning and homework.
- A modern auditorium complete with retractable seating, modern lighting and a sound system to complement any production.
- Great facilities in the Music department including an Apple Mac technology and media suite, complete with new machines for 2022.
- Every classroom in the academy has been refurbished ensuring there is a consistent learning environment throughout the academy.

Sports Facilities

- Our leisure centre offers comprehensive facilities to both our students and community users, including a recently refurbished Sports Hall, with brand new flooring and changing rooms for 2022.
- We enjoy an all-weather 3G sports pitch (recarpetted in Spring 2022) providing a great outdoor resource.
- Additionally, tennis courts, cricket pitches and nets, rugby pitches, netball courts and athletic facilities add to the range of activities students can enjoy at Bucklers Mead.

Learning that Challenges and Engages

We know that all students are capable of excellence. Our exciting curriculum will inspire all students with a thirst for learning, and will equip them with a diverse range of knowledge and skills that will allow them to choose any future educational and career paths.

Excellent Teaching

Our teachers are dedicated to ensure that all lessons stimulate an intellectual curiosity and allow all learners to develop their talents and interests. We believe in excellence and have a passion to provide the best education for your child - we value every student and believe everyone wants to and can succeed. We have an experienced, hardworking and caring team of staff who are highly committed to empower and prepare our students for future education and employment.

Constantly Challenged

Our teachers know each student's starting point and regularly assess them to evaluate their progress. This knowledge of their needs is used to reshape their learning so that each child is challenged to excel.

Enthusiastic Learners

Our students frequently tell us that they love being challenged to learn. Buckler's Mead Academy teachers provide opportunities for students to consolidate their learning through homework and independent study. This encourages students to develop the skills, confidence and motivation needed for lifelong independent learning and to manage particular demands, such as GCSE deadlines.



Homework Tracking

Students are expected to complete 'independent learning' in order to enhance their learning and develop resilience. This homework is tracked by staff to ensure there is a positive impact on learning.

Read to Succeed

Our Read to Succeed programme ensures that all learners have the opportunity to engage in seminal world literature. This enables all learners to know how their context relates to the rich diversity of cultures across time and place, and to appreciate transcendent themes and concepts of the past in the present and the present in the past. Every day in tutor time students read a carefully selected text, for 30 minutes, from within the four pillars of literature:

- Morality and Law
- Diversity and Otherness
- Gender and Identity
- Autonomy and Agency

The Curriculum

The curriculum followed at Buckler's Mead Academy is designed to enable our students to become:

- Successful learners, who enjoy learning, make progress and achieve
- Confident individuals, who are able to lead safe and healthy lives
- Responsible citizens, who make a positive contribution to society
- Aspirational young people, who are aware of the opportunities which exist outside of their immediate experience

Personal Development

All students within the academy study a personal development curriculum that enables them to discover and delve into topics such as social and emotional health and wellbeing, British values, relationships and living in the wider world.

Broad Curriculum

Students in Years 7, 8 and 9 are taught a broad range of subjects, which form the foundation of their learning in the academy. These subjects include English, Mathematics, Science, Art, Beliefs and Values, Computer Science, Design Technology, Drama, Geography, History, Modern Foreign Languages (French and/or German), Music, and Physical Education.

Specialised Key Stage Four Curriculum

From the start of Year 10 students are able to exercise a degree of choice where they can personalise their learning and complete a combination of courses suited to their interests and talents. The academy offers a range of GCSEs, vocationals and alternative accreditations.

Enjoyable Academy

Our watch words are Positive, Self-motivated, Resilient, Determined and Reflective. We want our students to enjoy their time in the academy and take a full part in lessons because they are stimulated, engaged and curious.

We have a designated Careers Advisor who works with students from Year 7 to Year 11, offering information, **advice** and **guidance** on what is available for students after they leave the academy.


Raising Aspirations
