Objectives in spending PPG

The way we use our Pupil Premium funding is based on the following principles:

- Enrichment of the curriculum - ensures that all children whether they are from a disadvantaged background or not, have equal access to our provision of workshops, visiting writers/artists and out of school visits (including with children from other schools)
- Targeted support - is provided to help identified pupils successfully access all areas of the curriculum
- Progress - to ensure equality of opportunity and appropriate progress for all
- Providing social and emotional support and interventions to improve attendance and behaviour

Nature of support 2017/18

The Pupil Premium funding that is received by the school annually is used in a variety of ways in order to improve pupil attainment and to help overcome any barriers to learning, as well as enhancing the learning opportunities for all children.

The child has appropriate support within the classroom to ensure progress. The child is monitored closely and the child's progress is regularly assessed. Class teachers sets targets for the child and ensures that there is a particular focus on the pupil making at least expected progress.

Pupil Premium it will be used to provide additional teaching assistant support within the classroom and guest speakers to inspire, motivate and extend pupils' ideas and opportunities for learning.

Free training for Teachers and Teaching Assistants to support learning and ensure access to the curriculum for pupils in receipt of PPG.

Impact of Pupil Premium Grant

At Leigh on Mendip we carefully track the progress of each and every child, using teacher assessment and Standardised Teacher Assessment Tasks. Data on pupils' progress and attainment is analysed regularly throughout the year. Targets are set and reviewed for each child at these regular pupil progress meetings. Our aim is for every child to make appropriate progress within the national curriculum each year. Governors analyse the impact of the schools provision for our pupils regularly.
