We will be staying at the newly refurbished Mendip Activity Residential Centre at Churchill, Bristol, BS25 5PQ (photos are now available on their website). Mendip is situated in 250 acres of woodland on the edge of the Mendips with outdoor activities to challenge all abilities. Activities will take place over three sites so that children can experience a wide range of activities from abseiling and climbing to archery and bush craft. Mendip also has exclusive river access for canoeing, kayaking, raft building and a permanent assault course.
