Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Feel strong enough to express a range of emotions and grow in independence in most tasks
Increasingly follow rules, understanding why they are important.



Physical Development

Establishing a greater control when using tools such as pencils, scissors or cutlery

Develop their phonological awareness, so that they can:
spot and suggest rhymes
count or clap syllables in a word
Continue to learn one sound per week (d,g,o,c,e)
