Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our History topic in Term 3 on History through the Ages (Stone Age - Iron Age) I have arranged a visit for Rowan Class to visit Cheddar Gorge and Caves.

We will take part in a look around the museum of Prehistory, where the children will be given demonstrations of Stone Age survival skills by a costumed hunter-gatherer. We will also have a tour of Gough's Cave, where they will be given a talk on Stone Age life in the 'Daylight Zone' of Gough's Cave and will meet the Cheddar Man. In the afternoon we will have a chance to look around a second cave and end the day with a climb of Jacob's Ladder, from where they can tackle the 274 steps to the top of the staircase to reach a cliff top Lookout Tower.

This will take place on Tuesday 29th February 2024. We will leave school at 9.15am and return in time for the end of the school day. Your child will need to wear school uniform (where possible a logoed jumper or cardigan) on the top, a plain pair of joggers or leggings and a pair of comfortable shoes either trainers or walking boots. Your child will also need to bring a packed lunch to school this day.

We would ask for a voluntary contribution of £13.50 per child (£6.75 for those in receipt of Pupil Premium funding) towards the cost of this exciting trip and this can be paid via Parent Pay.

Please note if insufficient funds are received, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Similarly if you are having trouble meeting the required payment please come and see me.
