Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been several years since the school has been able to go on a whole school Christmas theatre trip but we are excited to announce that we have now booked to go to the Tobacco Factory in Bedminster to watch a production of the Snow Queen on Thursday 8th December.

We will leave school at 12.30pm and return to school at approximately 4pm. This means that if possible your child will need to bring a packed lunch on this day. School uniform must be worn.

Due to the ever increasing cost of transport, the trip will be at a cost of £19.20 per child. However, as a school we will subsidise the trip bringing the cost down to £17.20 per child. I appreciate that due to the cost of living crisis, for many families (especially if you have more than one child in the school) this amount may seem unaffordable. If you feel this is the case please come and see either myself or Dan Turull.

Similarly, if you feel that you are able to pay the non-subsided cost of the trip (£19.20) then the subsidy can be used to help another family. Payment has been set up on Parentpay.

Parents of children in receipt of Pupil Premium will be asked to donate 50% of the cost.

Please return permission slips to the office by the 7th November.

Please note that if we do not receive enough donations, the trip will sadly have to be cancelled.
