Transportation Arrangements - Your Feedback Needed

Unfortunately, our regular bus service providers are unable to assist with transportation to and from Millfield School. **Before we can confirm this event, we need to assess whether parents are able to assist us with the arrangements for transportation.**

The proposed arrangements would be:

- **Drop-off:** Students to be dropped off directly at Millfield School by 9:00am
- **Collection:** Parents to collect their children from Millfield School at 2:00pm
- **Meeting Point:** Main Sports Complex Car Park (signs will be posted)

We may be able to organise a limited shuttle-bus service for families who face significant transportation challenges, but this would depend on the overall need.
